JUDGMENT AND ORDER

BACKGROUND

1. The Applicant completed an investigation into the complaint lodged by Mr John Ramodibedi Jaycee Molale against Global Booming Investments CC (The Respondent).
2. The parties reached a settlement in the matter on 14 May 2018. However, the settlement agreement was filed with the Tribunal on 10 July 2018.
3. Section 74 (1) of the Act empowers the Tribunal to confirm the agreement as attached and marked “Annexure A” as a consent order. Section 74(1) states:

“If a matter has been investigated by the Commission, and the Commission and

the respondent agree to the proposed terms of an appropriate order, the Tribunal or a court, without hearing any evidence, may confirm that agreement as a consent order”

4. ORDER

After consideration by the Tribunal; it is hereby declared that:

4.1 The Settlement Agreement entered into between the Applicant and the Respondent on 14 May 2018 is made an order of the National Consumer Tribunal in terms of Section 74(1) of the Consumer Protection Act of 2008 (Annexure A of the record as attached).

4.2 There is no order made as to costs.
